(Some with regard to entry procedures, requirements, refunds, late & post entries may not be applicable to this show/event). **These rules and guidelines contain important information regarding animal health information and documentation, contact information and more that will be important to and applicable to this event.** It is important that you read thoroughly, understand, enter and comply with all rules pertinent to Oklahoma State Fair Horse Shows as listed on pages preceding show information and as available on the website. Your submission of entries and presence at OKC Fair Park indicates your understanding, acceptance and agreement of all rules published pertinent to this and other equine competitions held in conjunction with the 2026 Oklahoma State Fair. This includes release of all liability for all guests, exhibitors, owners, assistants and associates and agreement to all rules and guidelines published relative to this event.

ARRIVAL INFORMATION:

NEW IN 2026: NO ONE WILL BE ALLOWED ADMISSION WITHOUT ARMBAND OR ADMISSION TICKET. Allocated/pre-purchased parking passes/hangtags and/or exhibitor armbands MUST be picked up upon first time arrival at Gate 7 and presented to the Gate 7 staff for admission. "Credentials" (admission tickets, armbands, parking passes) will NOT be available at the Horse Show Office. We strongly encourage you to purchase any additional admission tickets that may be necessary for trainers, staff, guests, etc. prior to arrival.

- 1) **FIRST TIME ARRIVAL: BRING THE EXHIBITOR INVOICE/RECEIPT THAT WILL BE EMAILED TO THE REGISTERED OWNER AS ENTERED. FAILURE TO BRING THAT DOCUMENT MAY RESULT IN HAVING**
 - a. **TO PURCHASE ADDITIONAL ADMISSIONS AT THE GATE.**
- 2) Animals can only arrive through Gate 7. GPS Address: 3350 Black Gold Dr., Oklahoma City, OK 73107.
- 3) Watch for signs indicating the appropriate incoming lane designation.
- 4) Be aware of the days/times of permitted arrival and departure.

- 5) Have all required animal health documentation available and present to Health Inspectors at Gate 7 upon arrival.
- 6) Receive pre-purchased and allocated CREDENTIALS (*CREDENTIALS = armbands and/or parking permits*) from the credential office at Gate 7. (See more details in the section for ADMISSIONS on subsequent pages.)
- 7) Surrender admission tickets (and get hand stamped for same day return) and present allocated armband(s) at ticket takers station at Gate 7 for all individuals arriving with you.
- 8) Go to the Horse Show office in the Performance Arena for stall assignments and back numbers prior to unloading anything/anywhere. Be aware of the horse show office hours. (May not coincide with allowable arrival hours.)
- 9) NO exit via Gate 7 at any time. Exit is through Gate 8 ONLY at all times.
- 10) Pedestrian walk in with the appropriate armbands/tickets will be allowed through Gate 7 and/or Gate 8 between 6:30 a.m. and 10:30 p.m. Individual tickets can also be purchased at those gates during those hours. All pedestrians must be security scanned at each gate upon arrival.

STALLING:

- 1) Assigned stalling for horses entered in this show will be in Barn 6.
- 2) Stalls are mandatory for each individual horse. Horses cannot be shown out of trailers or maintained at OKC Fair Park outside of stalls. In the event that more stalls are needed OSF reserves the right to assign stalls in another available barn/building.
- 3) Free tack stalls for single owner/farm/stable(s) entered (cannot be shared by more than one owner, stable or farm) will be allocated as follows and are based on the actual number of horses being entered and shown and horse (not tack/equipment/feed) stalls being purchased for said horses:
 - a. Four-Five paid full fee horse stalls = One free tack stall
 - b. Six-Seven paid full fee horse stalls = Two free tack stalls
 - c. Eight or More paid full fee horse stalls = Three free tack stalls
 - d. Current year members (per membership entity) of the Oklahoma Draft Horse & Mule Association will be given use of one additional stall at no charge when submitting fully paid entries, inclusive of the payment of at least one other/additional horse stall, submitted and paid online, no later than August 15, 2026.
 - ❖ OSF will allot and assign these as entries are processed.
- 4) NO revision, disassembly or dismantling of stalls. Refer to General Rules for rules/policy regarding use of stalls.

FEED & BEDDING:

OKC Fair Park has a no outside bedding policy. The individual exhibitor may be charged \$5 per bag if an exhibitor brings in additional and/or excessive bedding. An onsite feed and bedding store is available for exhibitor convenience. Questions about this policy can be directed to the Feed & Bedding Department at OKC Fair Park. (405-948-6786) Exhibitors may bring in the feed of their choice.

ENTRY DEADLINES/ASSOCIATED FEES:

The **online entry process** will open July 15 and close September 16, 2026. All entries must be processed online (no manual/hand copy entry forms) with the following stipulations/exceptions:

- 1) Entries into the **OSF Heavy Horse Show** MUST be submitted, processed and paid with credit card **online**. Complete entries processed and paid by August 15, 2026 will not incur additional penalty. Any **entry additions made after August 15** to entries previously submitted will be assessed additional late fees as noted below. **No entries will be accepted after 4 p.m. for any classes scheduled to be held the following day.**
- 2) **Additional/late entries can be submitted with the following additional deadlines and penalties for the OSF Heavy Horse Show (only).**
 - ❖ **August 16 – August 31: ONLINE ENTRIES ONLY. Late fees:** Entries will be assessed \$100 additional per exhibitor (ownership entity) + \$10 additional per class added after August 15, 2026. Entries processed after August 31 will not be eligible for exhibitor armbands or parking passes and exhibitors will need to pay admission upon arrival. NEW entries processed/submitted after August 15 will NOT be considered for OSF High Point Awards or point accrual.
 - ❖ **September 1 – September 16: ONLINE ENTRIES ONLY. Late fees:** Entries will be assessed \$150 additional per exhibitor (ownership entity) + \$10 additional per class added after August 31, 2026. Not eligible for complimentary parking passes or exhibitor armbands.
 - ❖ **September 17 – until 4 p.m. the day prior to the first intended class. Must be submitted via hard copy/entry forms complete with all necessary paperwork and fees directly to the Horse Show office.** These entries will be assessed an additional late fee of \$200 per exhibitor (ownership entity) + \$15 per class added **after** September 16, and all fees must be paid with credit card or cash. No entries will be accepted after 4 p.m. the day prior to the first scheduled class of the intended show. Not eligible for any complimentary parking passes or exhibitor armbands or OSF High Point consideration/point accrual. Stall location subject to availability.

ADMISSION:

NEW IN 2026: No individual will be allowed entrance into OKCFP without presenting paid admission to ticketing staff upon arrival at Gate 7. All previously purchased credentials (armbands and parking passes/permits) will be available for pick-up at the credential office located directly outside of the Gate 7 entrance. Exhibitors will be required to stop within the arrival hours noted on page 1 of this document to pick up these credentials. **Consult the OSF Equine Competitions website for any changes in arrival procedures prior to your arrival at OKCFP.**

- 1) Make sure everyone in your vehicle (or arriving for this show) has a ticket/armband or is prepared to purchase appropriate admission in advance.
- 2) When picking up admission/parking from the credential office at Gate 7, be prepared to provide staff with the full name of the exhibitor (as entered).
 - a. Credentials will **not** be available at the Horse Show Office.
 - b. Credentials will **not** be provided at Gate 7 for any accounts with remaining/outstanding balances.
 - c. Credentials will **not** be available at Gate 7 for post entries. Purchase admission in advance or upon arrival through the ticket sellers at designated gates.
- 3) Exhibitors with account balances attached to a particular horse/entry will not be allowed entry into the show arena for competition.

Armband Information:

Exhibitor armbands will be given to complete entries processed online and paid in full no later than August 31. Individuals wearing an armband will be granted entry through designated gates for the dates designated on the armband (September 22-27).

- 1) Must be on exhibitor's wrist and cannot be transferred

- 2) **OPTIONAL:** Additional Exhibitor **Armbands** can be purchased, while supply lasts, WITH ENTRIES SUBMITTED IN ENTIRETY BY ENTRY DEADLINE OF AUGUST 31, 2026. Available for \$35.00 each. **LIMIT: two additional per owner/ownership entity.** Armbands will not be available and cannot be allocated, ordered or purchased after entry deadline of August 31, 2026.

Additional admission tickets needed must be purchased through the OK State Fair website in advance, or at the gate upon arrival (refer to www.okstatefair.com for additional information regarding advance/other discount ticket options). No one will be allowed entrance into OKCFP without paid or allocated admission.

Parking Permits:

One exhibitor parking permit will be allotted to each registered/entering owner/exhibitor entity with complete entries processed and submitted no later than August 31, 2026. Livestock Show Parking permits or other pre-paid parking permits are required for parking tow/passenger vehicles in designated "Paid Parking" lots.

- 1) After arriving and unloading, park trailer(s) in the designated trailer parking lot, south of Gate 7 at the intersection of Black Mesa Drive and Eighty-Niner/Geronimo Drive.
 - a. Do not park the tow/passenger vehicle in the livestock/equine trailer parking lot.
- 2) The parking permit is not good for gate admission, and it does not guarantee a parking place. Usage of permit is subject to rules as stated on the permit.
- 3) **OPTIONAL:** Additional **parking permit** hangtag: \$30.00 (**limited to one additional per exhibitor**, while supply lasts, and must be requested and paid with original online entries processed no later than August 31.)
For other parking accommodations, refer to and purchase through the Oklahoma State Fair ticketing website.

GENERAL RULES & SHOW INFORMATION:

Start/Session Times/Lunch/Dinner Breaks are Subject to Revision:

Oklahoma State Fair Horse Show management reserves the right to revise start times and show locations for all days/classes as well as combine classes after close of entries. Please re-visit the Oklahoma State Fair website and check with the horse show office to determine any additional information or possible changes available after September 1, 2026. Lunch and/or other breaks are at discretion of officials/show management and will be announced. All efforts will be made to provide any changes in starting times each day after all entries are processed. Anticipate evening performances.

Back Numbers:

All handlers/exhibitors, riders, handlers or drivers (or their conveyance) are required to wear or display OSF provided back number(s) when entering the competition arena. Entries will not be allowed into the show arena without this exhibitor/back number. Not wearing or displaying the correct number may subject the exhibitor to expulsion from the show arena and/or void exhibitor placing.

Golf Carts:

Use of individual/private owned golf carts or other similar motorized transport within the OKCFP gates is strictly prohibited. No golf carts will be allowed without OSF written authorization, insurance verification, fees and issued permit. Minors without a valid driver's license are not allowed to operate any motorized vehicle.

EXHIBITOR'S WAIVER & RELEASE OF LIABILITY:

By completing and submitting any/all entries into any OSF competition, all individuals associated with any contestant, exhibitor, owner, associate, assistant, guest and/or animal(s) by doing so releases, discharges and agrees to indemnify Oklahoma State Fair, Inc., OKC Fair Park, the City of Oklahoma City, and the City of Oklahoma City Public Property Authority (and all of their officers, directors, members, managers, agents, representatives and employees) ("Indemnified Parties") from any and all losses or expenses of any kind, civil penalties, crimes, and causes of actions (including cost for defense, settlement and attorney fees) arising from or related to (1) death or bodily injury to any person, (2) destruction, damage, loss of theft of any property, (3) any violation of any law or (4) any other claim, cause of action, damage or expense, which results from or arises out of any act or failure to act, claim, demand or action

arising from or by reason of personal injury that may occur to any associated individual(s) or animal(s) or properties entered or attending this Event being held at OKC Fair Park (OKCFP), whether caused by the actual or passive negligence of the Releasees, while aforementioned individual(s) are at OKCFP and/or competing, observing, working in, or for any purposes participating at the Oklahoma State Fair. All associates as mentioned herein voluntarily agree to the release and waiver of liability and indemnity agreement as indicated by their submission of entries and their presence at the OKCFP. All involved individuals are aware of and understand Oklahoma Statutes, Section 50 of Title 76 pertaining to the Oklahoma Livestock Liability Limitations Act. The person submitting these entries, therein agrees to accept authority to act as agent for actual and/or recorded owner(s) of any/all animal(s) being entered, if applicable, and, in doing so, indicates acceptance of all rules, regulations, liability limitations for all individuals so named as owner, trainer, agent, exhibitor, rider, handler, groom, guest and/or showman. The person submitting these entries accepts responsibility and verifies accuracy of all information provided herein. This release and waiver shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Oklahoma.

Your submission of entries and presence at OKC Fair Park indicates your understanding, acceptance and agreement of all rules published pertinent to this competition. This includes release of all liability for all guests, exhibitors, owners, assistants and associates and agreement to all rules and guidelines published relative to this event.

AWARDS:

HIGH POINT AWARDS will be offered in the following divisions:

- Gypsy Horse - Gypsy Amateur - Gypsy Youth
- Friesian Owner (Exhibitor) - Drum Horse - Farm Team Owner (Exhibitor/Single and/or Team entries in Farm Team designated classes)

- 1) **Only horses entered in full online by August 15 will be considered** for high point consideration and point accrual.
- 2) Points will be awarded for placings under each Judge in the Gypsy division/classes. Exception: No points awarded in class #'s 051, 052, 053, 105, 148 or Championship Halter classes.
- 3) Points will be awarded based on the placing and number of horses/teams/entries **shown and judged** in each qualifying class, listed herein. Example: Horse or Team A is placed 1st in a 6 horse/team high point eligible class. That means it would have placed above 5 other horses/teams (shown and judged) and would receive 5 points for placing 1st in that class. If Horse or Team A places 3rd in another/different high point eligible class with 7 entries shown and judged, Horse or Team A would get 4 points, placing above 4 horses/entries in that class.) (Basically, one point for each horse/entry they place above in each/any of the designated high point eligible classes.)
- 4) Championship Halter classes do not count toward OSF High Point award accumulation/accrual.
- 5) The following classes will be considered for OK State Fair high point accumulation for each award as listed.

CLASS SHOW RULES:

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to understand, enter and adhere to the traditional or governing rules of each class/breed/division.

- 1) It is important that you read, understand and enter in accordance with these rules with special attention to the rules governing cross entering of classes. In all classes, Judge's decision is final.
- 2) There will be a two-minute gate call rule in effect for all classes unless a tack change has been formally submitted to the Horse Show Office on the appropriate form at least 3 classes prior to the class in question.
- 3) An authorized/experienced adult over the age of 18 MUST accompany all youth drivers in any driving class.
- 4) A current copy of registration papers verifying current gender and current ownership must be submitted with entries for all horses entered in any Gypsy Horse, Drum Horse or Friesian class.
- 5) Open Liberty Class # 051: No entry fee but horse must be entered in at least one additional entry fee paid class and entered online within the deadlines noted herein. Non-pointed class, single set of ribbons awarded. Will be run with reference to GVHS rule 0.4 Liberty available on page 98 of the GVHS rulebook available at <https://vanners.org/wp-content/uploads/2026/05/2026-GVHS-Rule-Book-Revision-8.2.pdf>
- 6) Gypsy Horse designated classes will be run in accordance with the Gypsy Vanner Horse Society (GVHS) rules unless otherwise stated. Rules available at https://vanners.org/pdf_post/2026-show-rules-v-8-2/ Other classes will be conducted with reference to GVHS protocol and guidelines unless otherwise stated or pursuant to OSF guidelines. Farm/Team classes will be conducted pursuant to traditional rules applicable to those classes. OSF show management/administration decisions prevail.

GYPSY HORSE DIVISION:

*All horses entered in any class designated for Gypsy horses must be a full blood/purebred Gypsy horse and must be duly registered as such and be registered within at least one of the following registries/associations.

*A current, legible copy of the registration certificate MUST be submitted with entries verifying registration status, age, gender of horse and current ownership:

- Gypsy Vanner Horse Society (hereinafter referred to as GVHS)
- Gypsy Horse Registry of America (GHRA)
- Gypsy Horse Association (GHA)
- Traditional Gypsy Cob Association (TGCA)
- Irish Cob Society – Nederland (ICS)
- International Gypsy Equine Association (IGEA)

- 1) Horses entered in this division/classes designated Gypsy cannot be entered in any other division/classes unless class list indicates OPEN (or) ANY/ALL or inclusive of multiple divisions/types/breeds.
- 2) Gypsy Horse Classes: The same horse/rider combination/unit cannot cross enter into both Walk/Jog or Walk/Trot classes AND classes requiring three gaits (i.e. Walk/Jog/Lope (or) Walk/Trot/Canter) in any/all divisions.

- 3) Youth is defined as an individual who has not reached his/her 18th birthday as of January 1st of the current competition year. Refer to GVHS for additional Youth exhibitor protocol and rules.
- 4) Youth exhibitors may NOT show a stallion of any age in any class. Any Youth exhibitor anywhere on the show grounds, while riding a horse, is required to wear an equestrian safety helmet that is ATSM/SEI approved.
- 5) An Amateur Exhibitor is defined as an individual who has reached their 18th birthday as of 1/1/2026 and qualifies as an Amateur competitor pursuant to GVHS rules. Proof of GVHS Amateur status must be provided with entries. Go to <https://vanners.org/wp-content/uploads/2026/05/2026-GVHS-Rule-Book-Revision-8.2.pdf>
- 6) **IMPORTANT NOTE AND INFORMATION FOR 2026:** In order to be eligible for **GVHS** points:
 - a) It is mandatory that GVHS horse registration and owner's GVHS membership information (and Amateur status if applicable and entering ANY Amateur designated classes) be supplied in the initial online entry process and that a copy of each GVHS registered horse's GVHS registration papers, verifying current ownership and correct equine gender be submitted to the OSF Horse Show office prior to the start of the show.
 - b) The \$20.00 GVHS drug testing fee must be included and paid with the initial entry submission for every GVHS registered (or GVHS pending registration) horse.

DRAFT TYPE HORSE DIVISION:

Halter class #'s 030 & 032 open to Draft type breeds NOT otherwise eligible for the purebred Friesian division/classes; nor the Drum Horse division/halter classes nor the Gypsy Horse division/classes. Must be at least 50% Draft Horse breed(s). For example: cross bred or part bred Friesians (not registered with FHANA/KFPS and not eligible for any other purebred Friesian class); or any purebred or at least 50% Draft breed such as Percheron, Belgian, Shire, Suffolk, Clydesdale, Haflinger, American Cream would be eligible for this division/these classes and may not cross enter into other division halter classes unless class list indicates OPEN (or) multiple divisions/types/breeds. DRUM horses can enter performance classes indicated Draft/Drum. Horses entered in Draft/Drum performance classes **WILL BE ALLOWED** to enter both Walk/Jog or Trot and Walk/Jog/Lope or Walk/Trot/Canter classes. (I.e. will be allowed to enter both 2-gait and 3-gait classes with same rider.)

DRUM HORSE DIVISION:

Horses may be registered with any registry but must be of Gypsy and Clydesdale and/or Shire heritage only. Horses eligible for another division noted above may not cross enter halter classes unless class list indicates OPEN (or) multiple/additional divisions/types/breeds. Performance classes indicated Draft/Drum will be open to Draft type horses defined above as well as Drum Horses. A current, legible copy of the registration certificate **MUST** be submitted with entries verifying registration status, age, gender and current ownership. Horses entered in Draft/Drum performance classes **WILL BE ALLOWED** to enter both Walk/Jog or Trot and Walk/Jog/Lope or Walk/Trot/Canter classes. (I.e. will be allowed to enter both 2-gaited and 3-gaited classes with same rider.)

FRIESIAN HORSE DIVISION:

The Friesian classes will be run basically with the GVHS rule format unless specified otherwise. Exhibitors should familiarize themselves with all applicable rules and enter and compete accordingly. Classes designated Friesian will be open to purebred Friesians registered with a recognized and accredited Friesian breed registry. Copies of registration papers verifying registration status and indicating current ownership and gender of horse **MUST** be submitted simultaneously with online show entries. Friesians or cross bred/part bred Friesians not duly registered with an accredited Friesian registry may enter into the Draft Horse Division classes noted above but will not be eligible for OK State Fair Friesian high point award point accumulation or credit. Registered partbred Friesians will also be allowed to show in the Friesian Showmanship, Costume and/or Equitation classes (Class #'s 038, 074, 076, 094, 106, 108 & 140.)

FARM TEAM CLASSES/DIVISION:

- 1) Ribbons will be awarded to 6th place. \$25 from each \$30 Farm Team open class entry fee will be jackpotted back and paid post-Fair to first three places: 50%, 30% and 20% in each class.
- 2) Only classes designated Farm/Team classes will be jackpotted.
- 3) Exhibitors (owners) **MUST** supply a completed and legible W-9 prior to the close of the Fair to be considered eligible for any prize money.
- 4) \$800.00 provided by the Oklahoma State Fair will be paid to the first three places in each of the Farm Team Finals classes (#'s 098 and #123). 1st place will receive \$175.00; 2nd place will receive \$125.00 and 3rd place will receive \$100.00.
- 5) Winners and placings in timed event classes will be determined by the fastest times. Time penalties and deductions will be applied/added for course infractions, knock-overs, etc.
- 6) Draft Farm Team exhibitors are allowed and encouraged to enter any other applicable class designated for Draft/Drum horses.

- 1) Start times for each session may be revised after close of entries.
